Yantai City

- It is located in the eastern part of the Shandong Peninsula and bordering both the Yellow and Bohai Seas.
- It has 230 offshore islands and seven natural bays.
- It has a 1038 km-long golden coastline connects the mountains and the sea.
- It has four distinctive seasons so that you can enjoy beautiful scenery all year long.
- It is a winner of the United Nations Habitat Award.
- It has been consistently voted one of China's most charming cities.
- It was awarded the title of “National historical and cultural city”.
- It is one of China's first 14 open coastal cities.
- It is a hub port for the “One Belt One Road” Initiative.
- It was awarded the title of “the best leisure city in China”.
- It is the only International Wine City in Asia.
- It was awarded the title of “National Excellent Social Management city”.
- It is the birthplace of Wu Style Taiji and Mantis Style Boxing.
- It is one of the birthplaces of Jiaodong folk culture and Shandong cuisine.



Yantai University

- To the east there is the Yellow Sea, which makes Yantai university the closest coastal university in China and it has the longest coastline.
- It is a key comprehensive and high-level university in Shandong Province.
- The university was jointly established by Peking University and Tsinghua University in 1984.
- In 1998, Yantai University became authorized to confer master's degrees.
- In 2012, Yantai University was recognized as a centre of prestigious education by the Shandong government, in particular they recognized the university's training in Law and Engineering as being of national importance. That same year the university was approved to enroll doctoral students.
- In 2020, Yantai University was granted the qualification to recruit postdoctoral fellows and its departments of Law, Medicine, Chemistry, Pharmacology and Toxicology, Engineering and Material Sciences were further recognized by the Shandong government.
- Yantai University has more than 30,000 students, studying over 10 disciplines including: culture, science, engineering, law, agriculture, medicine, economics, management, education, and art.





- As one of the first universities allowed to accept foreign students in China, Yantai University has had students from over forty countries and regions.
- Yantai University has endeavored to promote international exchange and has established partnerships with more than 150 universities and institutions from 30 countries and regions.
- The university hosts several major international tests, including the Official Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK), the HSK Speaking Test (HSKK), and the Korean Proficiency test (TOPIK).
- Yantai University offers different scholarships to international students including the Chinese Government Scholarship program, the Shandong Provincial Scholarship, and the International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship.

✂ Whether short-term or long term, Chinese language classes are offered all year round with applications open for the fall or summer semesters.

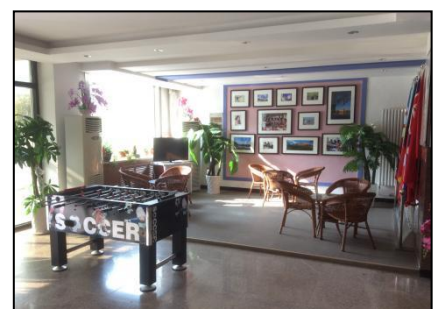

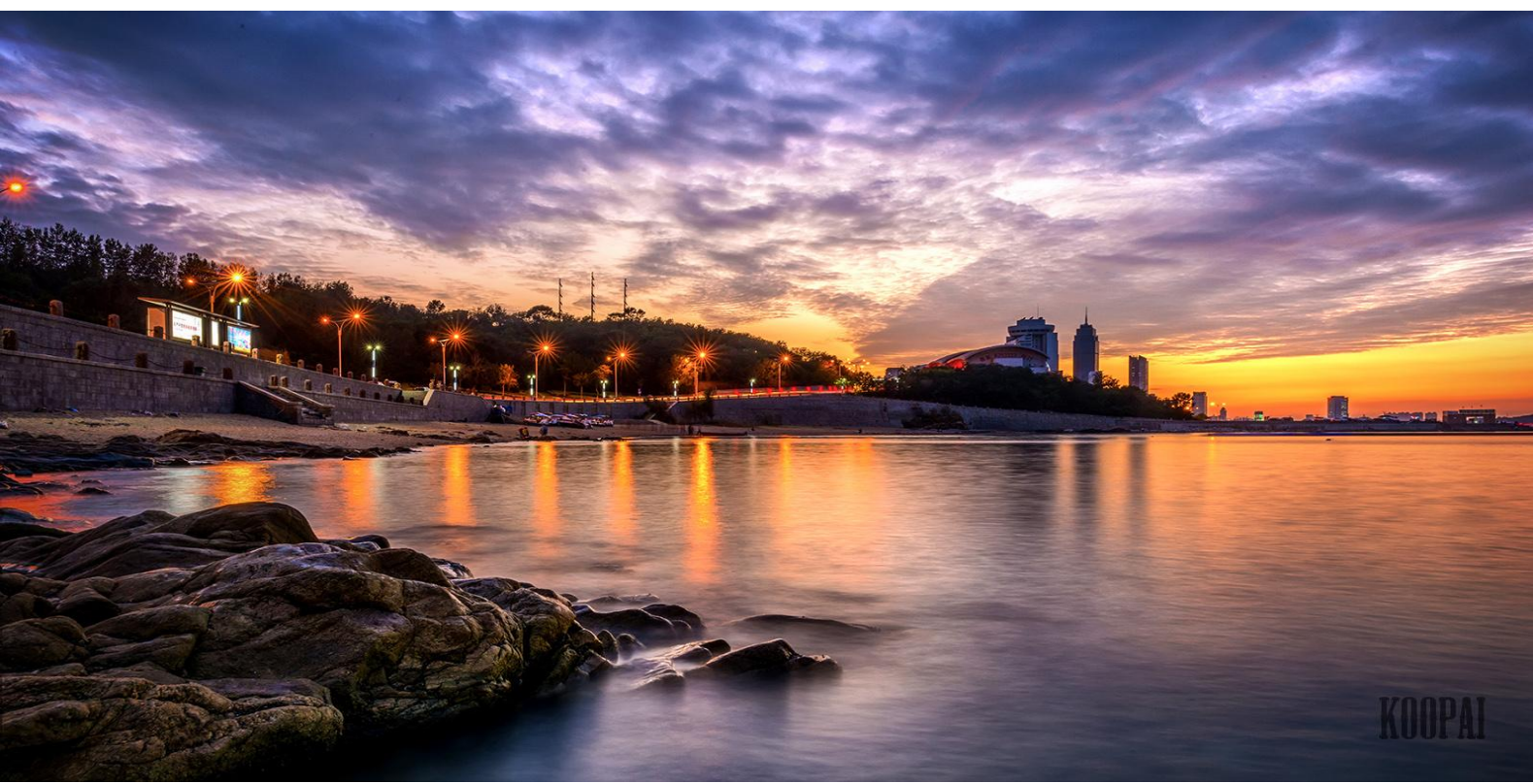
2. International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship

Admission Requirements

- Mentally and physically healthy, of good character with a positive attitude towards China; and high academic performance; and no criminal record;
- Chinese Language bachelor's degree and non-degree program: high school degree or above; No language requirements;
- Other major Undergraduate program: high school degree or above; HSK4 level;
- Master program: Bachelor degree or above; HSK5 level;
- Doctoral program: Master degree or above; HSK5 level;
- Aged between 18 to 40 years old.

Application Materials

- Copy of your passport
- Completed Application form
- Scanned copies of your high school diploma and transcripts, or a certificate from the university you are currently studying at
- Any HSK certificates you currently hold
- Certificate of Non-criminal Record
- Physical Examination Record for Foreigner
- Bank statement (balance over RMB 10,000 for language students and over RMB 30,000 for academic degree students)
- Two recommendations from your previous professors (for postgraduate applicants only)

Note:

- If you have work experience, please provide proof related to your present or previous employment.
- If there are children under 18 years old accompanying you, then please provide a proof of their relationship to you that has been notarized by your local Chinese embassies or consulate, for example a copy of their birth certificate.
- All materials must be issued in Chinese or English.

Timeline

1. Application deadline: Jan 15th, 2026.
2. On-campus registration: Mar 12th - 13th, 2026.
3. Semester Starting Date: Mar 16th, 2026.
4. Semester Ending Date: Early Jul 2026.

Application Process and Applying for your Student Visa

- First, the university will examine your application materials.
- If accepted, the university will send you a “Letter of Acceptance” and a “Visa Application For Study in China” (JW202 form) or an “Information Form for Foreign Students' Short-term Visit” (DQ form).
- You will then need to take this form (and other application materials as specified on your local Chinese embassy / consulate’s website) to your nearest Chinese embassy or consulate to apply for a student entry visa.
- Students should register on time, according to the time noted on their “Letter of Acceptance”.
